Explanatory note

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order, which comes into force on the 28th day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*, inserts the name Research and Education Advanced Network New Zealand Limited into Part 2 of Schedule 1 of the Ombudsmen Act 1975. The effect of this is that the Ombudsmen Act 1975 and the Official Information Act 1982 both apply to Research and Education Advanced Network New Zealand Limited.
