Explanatory note

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order, which comes into force on 1 December 2006, amends Schedule 1 of the Ombudsmen Act 1975 by—

- omitting Terralink NZ Limited from Part 2;
- adding Aviation Security Service, National Pacific Radio Trust, New Zealand Food Safety Authority, and Veterans’ Affairs New Zealand to Part 2;
- omitting Hospital Boards from Part 3.
