**THE ORCHARD AND GARDEN DISEASES ACT EXTENSION  
ORDER 1940.**

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House at Wellington, this 14th day of May, 1940.

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Orchard and Garden Diseases Act, 1928, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following Order.

---

ORDER.

1. This Order may be cited as the Orchard and Garden Diseases Act Extension Order 1940.

2. The diseases known as the Australian grape-vine moth (*Phalaenoides glycinæ*), grass-grub (*Pentodon australis*), and the Argentine ant (*Iridomyrmex humilis*) are hereby declared to be diseases within the meaning of the Orchard and Garden Diseases Act, 1928.

3. The First Schedule to the said Act is hereby extended by including therein the diseases mentioned in clause 2 hereof.

4. This Order shall come into force on the day following notification in the *Gazette* of the making hereof.
