# GALWAY, Governor-General. ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House at Wellington, this 14th day of May, 1940.

### Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

Pursuant to the Orchard and Garden Diseases Act, 1928, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following Order.

#### ORDER.

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Orchard and Garden Diseases Act Extension Order 1940.
- 2. The diseases known as the Australian grape-vine moth (*Phalaenoides glycinae*), grass-grub (*Pentodon australis*), and the Argentine ant (*Iridomyrmex humilis*) are hereby declared to be diseases within the meaning of the Orchard and Garden Diseases Act. 1928.
- 3. The First Schedule to the said Act is hereby extended by including therein the diseases mentioned in clause 2 hereof.
- 4. This Order shall come into force on the day following notification in the *Gazette* of the making hereof.
