PURSUANT to the Orchard and Garden Diseases Act, 1928, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following Order.

#### ORDER

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Orchard and Garden Diseases Act Extension Order 1943.
- 2. The disease known as bacterial-spot (*Bacterium pruni*) is hereby declared to be a disease within the meaning of the Orchard and Garden Diseases Act, 1928.
- 3. The First Schedule to the said Act is hereby extended by including therein the disease mentioned in clause 2 hereof.
- 4. This Order shall come into force on the day following notification in the *Gazette* of the making hereof.
