PURSUANT to the Orchard and Garden Diseases Act, 1928, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following Order.

ORDER

1. This Order may be cited as the Orchard and Garden Diseases Act Extension Order 1944.*

2. The diseases mentioned in the Schedule hereto are hereby declared to be diseases within the meaning of the Orchard and Garden Diseases Act, 1928.

3. The First Schedule to the said Act is hereby extended by including therein the diseases mentioned in the Schedule hereto.

4. This Order shall come into force on the day following notification in the *Gazette* of the making hereof.

SCHEDULE

Bark-blotch (Ascochyta corticola). Black-aphis (Aphis citricidus). Citrus-borer (Aemona hirta). Citrus-blast (Pseudomonas syringae). Circular-black-scale (Chrysomphalus rossi). Hemispherical scale (Saissetia coffeae). Hard-wax scale (Ceroplastes sinensis). Soft-wax scale (Ceroplastes destructor). Thrips (Heliothrips haemorrhoidalis).
