ORDER IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to subsections (2) and (3) of section 8 of the Area Health Boards Act 1983, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) This order may be cited as the Otago Area Health District Order 1988, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Otago Area Health District Order 1988\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).

(2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of October 1988.

**2. Combined districts**—Clause 4 of the principal order is hereby amended by adding, as subclause (2), the following subclause:

“(2) The number of members to be elected in common as the representatives of each such combined district shall be as specified in the Schedule to this order.”
