**THE OIL FUEL EMERGENCY REGULATIONS 1939,
AMENDMENT NO. 2.**

November, 1939.

THE HON. W. NASH PRESIDING IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Oil Fuel Emergency Regulations 1939, Amendment No. 2.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Oil Fuel Emergency Regulations 1939* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).

3. These regulations shall come into force on the day of notification in the *Gazette* of the making hereof.

4. The principal regulations are amended by adding thereto the following heading and additional regulation :—

“SUSPENSION OF CONTROL OR RESTRICTIONS.

“40. The Minister of Supply may from time to time, by notice under his hand published in the *Gazette*, suspend indefinitely, or for the period of time set out in the notice, the application, operation, and requirements of any one or more of Regulations 10 to 28 inclusive and 34 to 39 inclusive of these regulations.”
