**THE OIL FUEL EMERGENCY REGULATIONS 1939.
AMENDMENT NO. 4.**

GALWAY, Governor-General.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House at Wellington, this 17th day of April, 1940.

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Oil Fuel Emergency Regulations 1939, Amendment No. 4.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Oil Fuel Emergency Regulations 1939* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).

3. The principal regulations are amended by inserting, next following Regulation 10 thereof, the following additional regulation :—

“ 10A. No person shall sell or agree to sell or offer or seek to sell, and no person shall purchase or agree to purchase or offer or seek to purchase, any oil fuel if the sale or purchase which is effected or agreed to or proposed or sought to be made is a sale or purchase of a kind not authorized by these regulations.”

4. Regulation 37 of the principal regulations (as set out in Regulation 5 of Oil Fuel Emergency Regulations 1939, Amendment No. 1)† is amended by inserting, after the words “ not earlier than ”, the words “ and not later than or only during such period or periods as ”.
