



**THE OIL FUEL EMERGENCY REGULATIONS 1939,
AMENDMENT NO. 7**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

THE HON. D. G. SULLIVAN PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Oil Fuel Emergency Regulations 1939, Amendment No. 7, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Oil Fuel Emergency Regulations 1939* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the seventh day following the date of notification in the *Gazette* of the making thereof.

2. Regulation 5 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking paragraph (h), and substituting the following paragraph:—

“(h) To require any person to furnish to the Controller, or as he may direct, such information, whether by way of returns, statements, statistics, or otherwise howsoever, relating to oil fuel or oil fuel licenses or coupons issued under these regulations and the acquisition, possession, use, and disposal thereof and dealing therewith as the Controller may deem necessary, and to require that any such information be verified by statutory declaration.”
