**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Oil Fuel Emergency Regulations 1939, Amendment No. 9, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Oil Fuel Emergency Regulations 1939\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking Regulation 46 (which relates to the control of char), and also revoking the definition of the term "char" in Regulation 2.

3. The regulations cited as the Oil Fuel Emergency Regulations 1939, Amendment No. 6, are hereby consequentially revoked.
