1. (1) This Order may be cited as the Oil Fuel Emergency Regulations Revocation Order 1950.
- (2) This Order shall come into force on the 1st day of June, 1950.
2. The Oil Fuel Emergency Regulations 1939 and all amendments thereof* are hereby revoked.
