PURSUANT to the Fisheries Act 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. **Title**—These regulations may be cited as the Oyster Fishing Regulations 1946, Amendment No. 5, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Oyster Fishing Regulations 1946* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. **Closed season for taking oysters**—Regulation 15 of the principal regulations (as amended by regulation 2 of the Oyster Fishing Regulations 1946, Amendment No. 2) is hereby further amended by omitting the words “January, and February”, and substituting the words “and January, and the first 14 days of February”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations reduce the closed season for taking oysters. The closed season will end on the 14th day of February each year instead of the last day of February.
