ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 21st day of August 1972

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Fisheries Act 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Oyster Fishing Regulations 1946, Amendment No. 7, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Oyster Fishing Regulations 1946* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*, and shall continue in force until the 14th day of September 1972, and shall then expire with that date and thereupon be deemed to be revoked.

2. Start of close season for taking oysters in 1972 postponed—Notwithstanding anything in regulation 15 of the principal regulations (as substituted by regulation 2 of the Oyster Fishing Regulations 1946, Amendment No. 6), the period commencing with the 1st day of September 1972 and ending with the 14th day of September 1972 shall be deemed not to be a close season for the taking of oysters in the Southern Area, and, subject to the provisions of these regulations other than the said regulation 15, during that period it shall be lawful to take oysters in that area.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The effect of these regulations is to enable oyster fishing to take place in the Southern Area in the period commencing with 1 September 1972 and ending with 14 September 1972.
