**THE OTAGO INLAND HARBOURS REGULATIONS 1969,
AMENDMENT NO. 3**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 21st day of March 1977

Present:

THE HON. DUNCAN MACINTYRE PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Harbours Act 1950, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Otago Inland Harbours Regulations 1969, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Otago Inland Harbours Regulations 1969* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the seventh day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Navigation through Kawarau Falls flood-control gates—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking regulation 3, and substituting the following regulation:

“3. No person shall navigate any vessel through the Kawarau Falls flood-control gates except in accordance with the following rules:

“(a) Vessels proceeding downstream shall be navigated through the second arch of the control gates from the western bank:

“(b) Vessels proceeding upstream shall be navigated through the sixth arch of the control gates from the western bank.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations prescribe revised rules for the navigation of vessels through the flood-control gates of Kawarau Falls on the Kawarau River.
