**THE OVERSEA PASSENGERS EMERGENCY REGULATIONS 1939,

THE RIGHT HON. P. FRASER PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Oversea Passengers Emergency Regulations 1939, Amendment No. 1.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and deemed part of the Oversea Passengers Emergency Regulations 1939* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

3. The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking Regulation 4, and substituting the following regulation :—

“ 4. Every such permit shall cease to be in force on the expiration of three calendar months after the date thereof, and shall be returned to the Minister or the Under-Secretary upon revocation or other determination thereof.”
