Pursuant to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Oversea Passengers Emergency Regulations 1939, Amendment No. 1.
- 2. These regulations shall be read together with and deemed part of the Oversea Passengers Emergency Regulations 1939* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- 3. The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking Regulation 4, and substituting the following regulation:
- "4. Every such permit shall cease to be in force on the expiration of three calendar months after the date thereof, and shall be returned to the Minister or the Under-Secretary upon revocation or other determination thereof."
