### THE OPTICIANS REGULATIONS 1930, AMENDMENT NO. 5

THE HON. K. J. HOLYOAKE PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

Pursuant to the Opticians Act, 1928, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

#### REGULATIONS

- 1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Opticians Regulations 1930, Amendment No. 5, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Opticians Regulations 1930\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of April, 1951.
- 2. The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking regulation 10, and substituting the following heading and regulation:

#### " FEES

- "10. (1) The fee for examination in each section shall be £5:
- "Provided that in the event of failure the candidate may apply for re-examination on payment of a further fee of £3.
- "(2) The fee for a certificate of having passed the examination under the said Act shall be £2.
- "(3) The fee for registration under section 6 of the said Act shall be £5.
- "(4) The fee for a certificate of registration under the said Act shall be 10s.
  - "(5) The fee for an annual practising certificate shall be £1.
- "(6) The fee for any alteration or alterations of, or addition or additions to, the register, other than a change of address, shall be £1.
- "(7) The fee for a search of the register in respect of the name of any person shall be 5s.
- "(8) The fee for the restoration to the register of any name, after its removal therefrom, shall be £2.
  - "(9) All fees shall be prepaid."
