## THE HON. S. G. HOLLAND PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Animals Protection and Game Act, 1921–22, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

#### REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Opossum Regulations 1947, Amendment No. 2.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and deemed part of the Opossum Regulations 1947\* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).

**3.** These regulations shall come into force on the day following notification in the *Gazette* of the making thereof.

4. The Schedule to the principal regulations, as added by Regulation 5 of the Opossum Regulations 1947, Amendment No. 1, is amended by inserting immediately before the words "Marlborough Acclimatization District," the following words :—

"Waimarino Acclimatization District .-- In the area following, that is to say :--

"That portion of Taurewa State Forest situated in Blocks VI and VII, Tongariro Survey District, Wellington Land District; as the same is delineated on the plan marked I.A. 49/1/K deposited in the Head Office, Department of Internal Affairs, at Wellington, and thereon bordered red."
