**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

THE HON. S. G. HOLLAND PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Animals Protection and Game Act, 1921-22, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

---

**REGULATIONS**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Opossum Regulations 1947, Amendment No. 2.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and deemed part of the Opossum Regulations 1947\* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).

3. These regulations shall come into force on the day following notification in the *Gazette* of the making thereof.

4. The Schedule to the principal regulations, as added by Regulation 5 of the Opossum Regulations 1947, Amendment No. 1, is amended by inserting immediately before the words "Marlborough Acclimatization District," the following words:—

" *Waimarino Acclimatization District*.—In the area following, that is to say:—

"That portion of Taurewa State Forest situated in Blocks VI and VII, Tongariro Survey District, Wellington Land District; as the same is delineated on the plan marked I.A. 49/1/K deposited in the Head Office, Department of Internal Affairs, at Wellington, and thereon bordered red."
