HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Orchard and Garden Diseases Act 1928, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Orchard Registration Regulations 1937, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Orchard Registration Regulations 1937* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Regulation 3 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by inserting in subclause (3), after the words "in the year 1947", the words "in the year 1954".

EXPLANATORY NOTE
