THE RIGHT HON. P. FRASER PRESIDING IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Orchard Registration Suspension Emergency Regulations 1942.
- 2. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the Orchard Registration Regulations 1937* made under the Orchard and Garden Diseases Act, 1928, or in any certificate of registration issued under those regulations in respect of an orchard, the registration of every orchard effected under those regulations and in force on the 30th day of September, 1942, or thereafter effected, shall, unless sooner cancelled or ceasing to be operative in accordance with the provisions of the said regulations, continue in force until the 30th day of September, 1947, or until the 30th day of September next after the date on which these regulations cease to be in force, whichever date be the later.
