**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

PURSUANT to section 7 of the Parliamentary Commissioner (Ombudsman) Act 1962, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

**ORDER**

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) This order may be cited as the Ombudsman's Salary Order 1967.

(2) This order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of April 1967.

**2. Salary of Ombudsman**—The salary of the Ombudsman shall be at the rate of £4,235 a year.

**3. Revocations**—The Ombudsman's Salary Order 1962\* and the Ombudsman's Salary Order 1964† are hereby revoked.
