Pursuant to the Occupational Therapy Act 1949, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Occupational Therapy Regulations 1964, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Occupational Therapy Regulations 1964* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the Gazette.
- 2. Regulation 21 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting from subclause (1), and also from subclause (2), the expression "£1 1s.", and substituting in each case the expression "£1 15s.".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations increase the fee payable in respect of each section of the State Examination in Occupational Therapy from £1 1s. to £1 15s.
