PURSUANT to section 32 of the Occupational Therapy Act 1949, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Occupational Therapy Regulations 1964, Amendment No. 7, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Occupational Therapy Regulations 1964* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- 2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the Gazette.
- 2. Fee for annual practising certificate—(1) Regulation 21 of the principal regulations (as substituted by regulation 2 (1) of the Occupational Therapy Regulations 1964, Amendment No. 5) is hereby amended by omitting from subclause (4) the expression "\$8", and substituting the expression "\$16".
- (2) Notwithstanding the provisions of regulation 21 (4) of the principal regulations (as amended by subclause (1) of this regulation), the fee for the issue of a practising certificate in respect of the year ending with the 31st day of March 1982 shall be \$8.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations increase the fee payable by an occupational therapist for an annual practising certificate. The fee is increased from \$8 to \$16, although the fee payable for a practising certificate in respect of the current year (which ends with 31 March 1982) remains at \$8.
