**THE OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY REGULATIONS 1964,  
AMENDMENT NO. 7**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 15th day of March 1982

Present:

THE RIGHT HON. D. MACINTYRE PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 32 of the Occupational Therapy Act 1949, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Occupational Therapy Regulations 1964, Amendment No. 7, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Occupational Therapy Regulations 1964\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

**2. Fee for annual practising certificate**—(1) Regulation 21 of the principal regulations (as substituted by regulation 2 (1) of the Occupational Therapy Regulations 1964, Amendment No. 5) is hereby amended by omitting from subclause (4) the expression “\$8”, and substituting the expression “\$16”.

(2) Notwithstanding the provisions of regulation 21 (4) of the principal regulations (as amended by subclause (1) of this regulation), the fee for the issue of a practising certificate in respect of the year ending with the 31st day of March 1982 shall be \$8.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations increase the fee payable by an occupational therapist for an annual practising certificate. The fee is increased from \$8 to \$16, although the fee payable for a practising certificate in respect of the current year (which ends with 31 March 1982) remains at \$8.
