

# PUBLIC FINANCE (TRANSFERS BETWEEN OUTPUTS) ORDER 1999

## ORDER IN COUNCIL

At Wellington this 28th day of June 1999

#### Present:

THE RIGHT HON JENNY SHIPLEY PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 5 of the Public Finance Act 1989, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, makes the following order.

### ORDER

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Public Finance (Transfers Between Outputs) Order 1999.
  - (2) This order comes into force on 30 June 1999.
- 2. Vote Courts—(1) It is directed that the amounts specified in subclause (2), being amounts appropriated in Vote Courts for the financial year ending on 30 June 1999 for the classes of outputs in that Vote that are specified in subclause (2), be transferred, in the amounts specified in

subclause (3), to the classes of outputs in that Vote that are specified in subclause (3).

(2) The classes of outputs from which, by subclause (1), amounts are directed to be transferred and the amounts that, by that subclause, are directed to be transferred from each of those classes of outputs are as follows:

D2 Collection or Enforcement of Fines and Civil Debts	170,000
D7 Information, Licensing and Agency Services	280,000

(3) The classes of outputs to which, by subclause (1), amounts are directed to be transferred and the amounts that, by that subclause, are directed to be transferred to each of those classes of outputs are as follows:

D3 Case Processing-Criminal	400,000
D4 Case Processing-Civil	50,000

- **3. Vote Defence Force**—(1) It is directed that six hundred and sixty-three thousand dollars (\$663,000) of the amount appropriated in Vote Defence Force for the financial year ending on 30 June 1999 for the class of outputs called D11 Air Combat Forces be transferred, in the amounts specified in subclause (2), to the classes of outputs in that Vote that are specified in subclause (2).
- (2) The classes of outputs to which, by subclause (1), amounts are directed to be transferred and the amounts that, by that subclause, are directed to be transferred to each of those classes of outputs are as follows:

- **4. Vote National Library**—It is directed that one hundred and ninety-one thousand dollars (\$191,000) of the amount appropriated in Vote National Library for the financial year ending on 30 June 1999 for the class of outputs called D2 Access to Information be transferred to the class of outputs in that Vote called D1 Collecting and Preserving Information.
- **5. Vote State Services**—It is directed that seventy thousand dollars (\$70,000) of the amount appropriated in Vote State Services for the financial year ending on 30 June 1999 for the class of outputs called D2 Policy Advice–Government Management be transferred to the class of outputs in that Vote called D3 Management Services.
- **6. Vote Statistics**—It is directed that eight hundred and forty-four thousand dollars (\$844,000) of the amount appropriated in Vote Statistics for the financial year ending on 30 June 1999 for the class of outputs called D3 Economic and Business Statistical Information Services be transferred to the class of outputs in that Vote called D2 Population, Social and Labour Force Statistical Information Services.

**7. Revocation**—The Public Finance (Transfer Between Outputs) Order 1998 (S.R. 1998/176) is revoked.

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order, which comes into force on 30 June 1999, is made under section 5 of the Public Finance Act 1989. That section authorises the Governor-General, by Order in Council, to direct that an amount appropriated in a Vote for a specified class of outputs be transferred to another class in that Vote where—

- (a) The amount transferred does not increase an appropriation for a financial year for a class of outputs by more than 5%; and
- (b) No other transfer under that section to that class of outputs has occurred during that financial year; and
- (c) The total amount appropriated for that financial year for all classes of outputs in that Vote is unaltered.

This order directs that-

- (a) A total of \$450,000 be transferred from the amounts appropriated for 2 classes of outputs in Vote Courts for the financial year ending 30 June 1999 to 2 other classes of outputs in that Vote:
- (b) The sum of \$663,000 be transferred from the amount appropriated for 1 class of outputs in Vote Defence Force for the financial year ending 30 June 1999 to 2 other classes of outputs in that Vote:
- (c) The sum of \$191,000 be transferred from the amount appropriated for 1 class of outputs in Vote National Library for the financial year ending 30 June 1999 to another class of outputs in that Vote:
- (d) The sum of \$70,000 be transferred from the amount appropriated for 1 class of outputs in Vote State Services for the financial year ending 30 June 1999 to another class of outputs in that Vote:
- (e) The sum of \$844,000 be transferred from the amount appropriated for 1 class of outputs in Vote Statistics for the financial year ending 30 June 1999 to another class of outputs in that Vote.

An order, which is now spent, but which was made under section 5 of the Public Finance Act 1989 in respect of the financial year ending on 30 June 1998, is revoked.
