PURSUANT to the Economic Stabilisation Act 1948, His Excellency the
Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the
Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as
the Price Freeze Regulations 1970, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read
together with and deemed part of the Price Freeze Regulations 1970*
(hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of February
1971.

2. Exempted goods—The Schedule to the principal regulations (as
amended by regulation 4 of the Price Freeze Regulations 1970, Amend-
ment No. 1) is hereby further amended by adding the following
paragraphs:

“(p) Motor spirits within the meaning of the Motor Spirits (Regula-
tion of Prices) Act 1933.

“(q) Diesel oil.

“(r) Other petroleum products in respect of which a tax is being
levied pursuant to the Local Authorities (Petroleum Tax)
Act 1970, to the extent that prices charged as at the 12th day
of November 1970 are increased by the amount of the tax
being so levied.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations add the following additional goods to the list of exempted goods:

- (a) Motor spirits:

- (c) Other petroleum products, to the extent of any local authorities petroleum tax being levied.
