

# THE PRICE FREEZE REGULATIONS 1970, AMENDMENT NO. 2

#### ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 26th day of January 1971

Pursuant to the Economic Stabilisation Act 1948, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

#### REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Price Freeze Regulations 1970, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Price Freeze Regulations 1970\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of February 1971.
- 2. Exempted goods—The Schedule to the principal regulations (as amended by regulation 4 of the Price Freeze Regulations 1970, Amendment No. 1) is hereby further amended by adding the following paragraphs:

"(p) Motor spirits within the meaning of the Motor Spirits (Regulation of Prices) Act 1933.

"(q) Diese'l oil.

"(r) Other petroleum products in respect of which a tax is being levied pursuant to the Local Authorities (Petroleum Tax)
Act 1970, to the extent that prices charged as at the 12th day of November 1970 are increased by the amount of the tax being so levied."

### EXPLANATORY NOTE
