**THE PENAL INSTITUTIONS (POLICE JAILS) NOTICE (NO. 2)
1987**

PURSUANT to section 4 of the Penal Institutions Act 1954, the Minister of Justice hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

1. Title—This notice may be cited as the Penal Institutions (Police Jails) Notice (No. 2) 1987.

2. Commencement and expiry—(1) This notice shall take effect from the 25th day of September 1987.

(2) This notice shall continue in force until the close of the 11th day of December 1987, and shall then expire.

3. Establishment of Police jails—The buildings described in the Schedule to this notice are hereby declared to be Police jails.

POLICE JAILS

1. The building known as the Tauranga Police Station, situated in Monmouth Street in the City of Tauranga.
2. The building known as the Timaru Police Station, situated at 20 North Street in the City of Timaru.
3. The building known as the Wanganui Police Station, situated in Bell Street in the City of Wanganui.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This notice declares the Tauranga Police Station, the Timaru Police Station, and the Wanganui Police Station to be police jails. The notice, which takes effect from 25 September 1987, continues in force until the close of 11 December 1987, and then expires.
