

## THE POSITIVE LIST OF CONTROLLED GOODS AND SERVICES 1981, AMENDMENT NO. 10

PURSUANT to section 82 of the Commerce Act 1975, the Minister of Trade and Industry hereby gives the following notice.

#### NOTICE

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Positive List of Controlled Goods and Services 1981, Amendment No. 10, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Positive List of Controlled Goods and Services 1981\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal notice).
  - (2) This notice shall come into force on the 29th day of March 1985.
- 2. Controlled goods and services—The First Schedule to the principal notice is hereby amended by omitting item No. 34 (an item relating to freight forwarding services).

### EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This notice, which comes into force on 29 March 1985, exempts freight forwarding from price control. Freight forwarding is the consolidation and conveyance of goods by land, sea, or air or by two or three of those modes of transport.
