1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Positive List of Controlled Goods and Services 1981, Amendment No. 5, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Positive List of Controlled Goods and Services 1981\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal notice).

(2) This notice shall come into force on the 12th day of March 1982.

**2. Controlled goods and services**—The First Schedule to the principal notice is hereby amended by omitting item No. 3 (an item relating to New Zealand-grown exotic timber) and item No. 4 (an item relating to certain timber services).
