THE PRACTISING OPTICIANS NOTICE 1955

Pursuant to regulation 8 of the Practising Opticians Regulations 1942,* the Minister of Health hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

- 1. This notice may be cited as the Practising Opticians Notice 1955.
- 2. The following resolution of the Opticians Board is hereby approved:
 Any registered optician may use in reference to himself, in any notice or advertisement relating to his calling, services, or wares as an optician, the description of optometrist.
- 3. This notice is in addition to the notices of resolutions of the Opticians Board dated the 11th day of January 1944† and the 20th day of June 1946‡.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

[This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.]

The effect of this notice is that a registered optician may describe himself, in any notice or advertisement permitted by the Practising Opticians Regulations 1942, as an optometrist, as well as using any other description that he is entitled to use under those regulations or under the earlier resolutions of the Board referred to in clause 3 of this notice.
