In pursuance of the powers conferred upon the Price Tribunal by the Control of Prices Emergency Regulations 1939,* and with the authority of the Minister of Industries and Commerce, the Price Tribunal hereby makes the following Price Order:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as Price Order No. 78.
- 2. Price Order No. 29† is hereby revoked.
- 3. The maximum price which may be charged by a grower for any kind of white oats shall be not more than 3s. 6d. per bushel in trucks, grower's station, sacks extra.
