THE PLANT QUARANTINE REGULATIONS 1957, AMENDMENT NO. 2

At the Government House at Wellington this 25th day of October 1961

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Orchard and Garden Diseases Act 1928, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Plant Quarantine Regulations 1957, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Plant Quarantine Regulations 1957* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 7th day after the date of their notification in the Gazette.
- 2. Subclause (2) of regulation 41 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking the first proviso, and substituting the following proviso:

"Provided that where the number of packages comprised in the consignment does not exceed 29 no inspection fee shall be payable:".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations provide that, where at the prescribed rate the inspection fee on consignments of fruit, vegetables, or plants imported into New Zealand would be less than 2s. 6d., no fee shall be payable.
