**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

PURSUANT to section 64 of the Police Act 1958, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Police Regulations 1959, Amendment No. 25, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Police Regulations 1959\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 14th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

**2. Candidates for appointment as cadets**—Regulation 14 (4) (b) of the principal regulations is hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

The Police Regulations 1959 presently provide that candidates for appointment as Police cadets must be no younger than 17 years and no older than 18 years and 3 months. These regulations remove this age requirement.
