# ORDER IN COUNCIL

At Wellington this 15th day of September 1986

## Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 64 of the Police Act 1958, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

### REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Police Regulations 1959, Amendment No. 25, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Police Regulations 1959\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 14th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Candidates for appointment as cadets—Regulation 14 (4) (b) of the principal regulations is hereby revoked.

#### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

The Police Regulations 1959 presently provide that candidates for appointment as Police cadets must be no younger than 17 years and no older than 18 years and 3 months. These regulations remove this age requirement.
