## THE PARLIAMENTARY SALARIES AND ALLOWANCES DETERMINATION 1988, AMENDMENT NO. 1

PURSUANT to section 16 of the Civil List Act 1979 and to section 19 (4) of the Higher Salaries Commission Act 1977 and to section 25 (j) of the Acts Interpretation Act 1924, the Higher Salaries Commission hereby makes the following determination (to which is appended an Explanatory Memorandum).

## DETERMINATION

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This determination may be cited as the Parliamentary Salaries and Allowances Determination 1988, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Parliamentary Salaries and Allowances Determination 1988\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal determination).
- (2) This determination shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of April 1988.
- 2. Expiry—This determination shall expire on the 30th day of June 1989.
- **3.** Additional allowance for Minister of Foreign Affairs—The Second Schedule to the principal determination is hereby amended by inserting, after clause 1, the following clause:
- "1A. There shall be paid to the Minister of Foreign Affairs, in addition to that Minister's expenses allowance under clause 1 of this Schedule, an allowance at the rate of \$6,000 a year to provide for expenses incurred in connection with that Minister's official duties."

## EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This determination, which is deemed to have come into force on 1 April 1988, provides for the payment of an additional allowance to the Minister of Foreign Affairs. This allowance is to provide for expenses incurred in connection with the official duties of the Minister. A similar allowance was provided for by the Parliamentary Salaries and Allowances Determination 1987.

Provision for this allowance should have been included in the Parliamentary Salaries and Allowances Determination 1988. Such provision was omitted from that determination as the Commission was giving further consideration to the change in responsibilities resulting from the re-organisation of the external relations area. The Commission is still studying the matter and the allowance previously provided to the Minister of Foreign Affairs is meanwhile being reinstated.
