At the Government Buildings at Wellington, this 18th day of December, 1945

THE RIGHT HON. P. FRASER PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 19 of the Appropriation Act, 1920, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following Order.

ORDER

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Public Service Salary Order 1945, No. 2.
- 2. This Order shall be deemed to have come into force from the 30th day of June, 1944.
- 3. The Public Service Salary Order 1945* and the scale set out in the Schedule thereto of salaries payable to officers of the Professional Division and the Clerical Division of the Public Service administered under the Public Service Act, 1912, are hereby revoked.
- 4. The scale set out in the Schedule hereto is hereby substituted for the scale hereby revoked.
- 5. An officer shall not be advanced from the 6th Subdivision of Class VI as shown in the scale set out in the Schedule hereto nor from the 10th Subdivision of the said Class VI until in each case he has given satisfactory proof to the Public Service Commissioner of his proficiency.
- 6. Unless in any case the said Commissioner otherwise directs, an officer shall not be advanced from the 10th Subdivision of the said Class VI until he has been for two years in receipt of the salary prescribed for the said 10th Subdivision.
- 7. An officer shall not be advanced to the 13th Subdivision of the said Class VI unless—
 - (a) His services are of the required standard of efficiency; and
 - (b) He has had not less than twenty years' continuous superannuation service; and
 - (c) He has for a continuous period of not less than eight years been in receipt of the salary prescribed by the scale set out in the Schedule hereto for officers of the 12th Subdivision of the said Class VI.
- 8. Except as otherwise prescribed in this Order, the increments of the respective subdivisions of each of the classes shown in the said scale shall be annual increments.
