At the Government House at Wellington this 30th day of June 1980

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

Pursuant to section 37 of the Plant Varieties Act 1973, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Plant Varieties Regulations 1975, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Plant Varieties Regulations 1975* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 14th day after the date of their notification in the Gazette.
- 2. Form of application—(1) Regulation 9 (1) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking paragraph (b), and substituting the following paragraph:
 - "(b) In a form provided by the Registrar for the purpose, or in a form acceptable to the Registrar."
- (2) The Third Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby consequentially revoked.
- 3. Increase in fees payable—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the Second Schedule, and substituting the Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations amend the Plant Variety Regulations 1975.
Regulation 2 provides that the form of application be that supplied by the Registrar for the purpose, and revokes the prescribed form in the Third Schedule.
Regulation 3 generally increases the fees payable under the principal regulations.
