



THE PLANT VARIETY RIGHTS (FEES) ORDER 1988

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At Wellington this 23rd day of May 1988

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 38 of the Plant Variety Rights Act 1987, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Plant Variety Rights (Fees) Order 1988.

(2) This order shall come into force on the commencement of the Plant Variety Rights Act 1987.

2. Fees—(1) The fees specified in the Schedule to these regulations must be paid in respect of the things referred to (being things authorised by the Plant Variety Rights Act 1987) in that Schedule.

(2) Where, at the request of an applicant, the Commissioner arranges an overseas test trial of a variety, the applicant must pay the Commissioner the cost of the trial.

3. Amount of goods and services tax included—The fees prescribed in this order are inclusive of goods and services tax under the Goods and Services Tax Act 1985.
