**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At Wellington this 20th day of June 1988

**Present:**

THE RIGHT HON. G. W. R. PALMER PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Quantity Surveyors Act 1968, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

---

**REGULATIONS**

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Quantity Surveyors Regulations 1969, Amendment No. 4, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Quantity Surveyors Regulations 1969\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 28th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

**2. Amount of goods and services tax included**—The principal regulations are hereby amended by inserting, after regulation 2, the following regulation:

“2A. The fees fixed by these regulations are inclusive of goods and services tax under the Goods and Services Tax Act 1985.”

**3. Fees**—Regulation 17 of the principal regulations (as amended by regulation 2 (1) of the Quantity Surveyors Regulations 1969, Amendment No. 3) is hereby amended—

- (a) By omitting from subclause (1) the expression “\$60.00”, and substituting the expression “\$99”;
- (b) By omitting from subclause (2) the expression “\$15.00”, and substituting the expression “\$24.75”;
- (c) By omitting from subclause (3) the expression “\$1.00”, and substituting the expression “\$5”;
- (d) By omitting from subclause (4) the expression “\$1.00”, and substituting the expression “\$5”;
- (e) By omitting from subclause (5) the expression “\$30.00”, and substituting the expression “\$49.50”;
- (f) By omitting from subclause (6) the expression “\$5.00”, and substituting the expression “\$10”.

**4. Examination fees**—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking regulation 40 (as inserted by regulation 2 of the Quantity Surveyors Regulations 1969, Amendment No. 1), and substituting the following regulation:

“40. (1) The fee for each request for permission to enter for the written examination shall be \$5.

“(2) The fee for the written examination shall be \$49.50 for each paper.

“(3) The additional fee for late entry for the written examination shall be \$10.

“(4) The fees prescribed by this regulation shall be payable to the Board.”

**5. Subjects of written examination**—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking regulation 38 (as inserted by regulation 2 of the Quantity Surveyors Regulations 1969, Amendment No. 1), and substituting the following regulation:

“38. The subjects of the written examination shall be—

“(a) Building economics:

“(b) Valuation:

“(c) Estimating and cost planning:

“(d) Professional practice:

“(e) Building management:

“(f) Contract administration:

“(g) Data co-ordination:

“(h) Law contracts and arbitration.”

**6. Forms**—(1) The Schedule to the principal regulations (as amended by regulation 3 of the Quantity Surveyors Regulations 1969, Amendment No. 3) is hereby amended—

(a) By omitting from form 3 the expression “\$60.00”, and substituting the expression “\$99”;

(b) By omitting from form 4 the expression “\$30.00”, and substituting the expression “\$49.50”.

(2) The Schedule to the principal regulations (as amended by regulation 3 of the Quantity Surveyors Regulations 1969, Amendment No. 1) is

hereby amended by omitting from clause 6 of form 7 the expression "\$1", and substituting the expression "\$5".

**7. Consequential revocations**—The following regulations are hereby consequentially revoked:

- (a) Regulation 2 (2) of the Quantity Surveyors Regulations 1969, Amendment No. 2:
- (b) The Quantity Surveyors Regulations 1969, Amendment No. 3.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*
