RE-IMPOSING A DUTY ON COPRA EXPORTED FROM COOK ISLANDS.

Enacting authority: His Excellency the Governor-General in Council. Date on which the regulations were made: 23rd day of December, 1936. Date of notification in *Gazette*: 8th day of January, 1937.

Whereas by Order in Council dated the 24th day of June, 1918, and published in the *Gazette* of the 11th day of July, 1918, at page 2562, regulations were made under the Cook Islands Act, 1915, prescribing a duty to be paid on all copra exported from the Cook Islands:

And whereas by Order in Council dated the 12th day of December, 1935, and published in the *Gazette* of the 19th day of December, 1935, at page 3987, the rate of duty on copra exported from any of the Cook Islands, other than Niue, was suspended for a period ending on the 31st day of March, 1936:

Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor-General, pursuant to the Cook Islands Act, 1915, and by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby prescribe that from the 31st day of December, 1936, a duty shall be payable upon copra exported from any of the Cook Islands, other than Niue, at the rate of twenty shillings a ton.

Issued under the authority of the Regulations Act, 1936. These regulations are administered by the Cook Islands Department.
