**THE REMOVAL AND ERECTION OF SAWMILLS NOTICE 1941.**

PURSUANT to the Supply Control Emergency Regulations 1939 and the Timber Emergency Regulations 1939, I, Daniel Giles Sullivan, Minister of Supply, hereby give public notice as follows:—

1. This notice may be cited as the Removal and Erection of Sawmills Notice 1941.

2. This notice shall come into force on the day following notification hereof in the *Gazette*.

3. No person shall without the precedent consent in writing of the Timber Controller remove to another site or cause to be removed to another site, or erect or cause to be erected, any machinery, plant, or equipment, capable of being used for the sawing or cutting of logs into flitches, planks, boards, scantlings, or case timber.

4. The provisions of this notice shall not apply to the maintenance or replacement of any such plant, machinery, or equipment as is referred to in clause 3 hereof.
