

THE RADIO AMENDMENT REGULATIONS 1943

At the Government Buildings at Wellington, this 24th day of March, 1943.

PURSUANT to the Post and Telegraph Act, 1928, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Radio Amendment Regulations 1943.
- 2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Radio Regulations 1932* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).
- 3. These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of April, 1943.
- 4. Paragraph (a) of clause (5) of Regulation 73 of the principal regulations is amended by deleting the words "who are the heads of their respective households".
