



THE ROTORUA AND ROTOITI HARBOUR AMENDING REGULATIONS 1952

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington, this 5th day of November 1952

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE GOVERNMENT IN COUNCIL
PURSUANT to the Harbours Act 1950, His Excellency the Administrator of the Government, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Rotorua and Rotoiti Harbour Amending Regulations 1952, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the regulations for controlling the traffic on Lake Rotorua and the management of wharves erected therein, and prescribing dues for the use thereof, made on the 12th day of January 1906, and published in the *Gazette* on the 18th day of January 1906* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Regulation 1 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the words "Minister in charge of the Department of Tourist and Health Resorts", and substituting the words "Minister of Internal Affairs".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

[This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.]

These regulations transfer the control as harbour authority for Lakes Rotorua and Rotoiti from the Department of Tourist and Health Resorts to the Department of Internal Affairs.

Date of notification in *Gazette*: 6 November 1952.
