

# THE ROTORUA AND TAUPO TROUT FISHING REGULATIONS 1980, AMENDMENT NO. 1

## ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 15th day of June 1981

#### Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Fisheries Act 1908 and section 14 of the Maori Land Amendment and Maori Land Claims Adjustment Act 1926, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

### REGULATIONS

- 1. Title, commencement, and application—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Rotorua and Taupo Trout Fishing Regulations 1980, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Rotorua and Taupo Trout Fishing Regulations 1980\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
  - (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of July 1981.
- (3) Regulation 5 of these regulations shall apply to all licences issued in respect of any period commencing on or after that day.
- 2. Restrictions on methods of fishing—(1) Regulation 17 (1) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting from paragraph (k) the word "device.", and substituting the words "device; or".

(2) The said regulation 17 (1) is hereby further amended by adding the

following paragraph:

"(1) Subject to this regulation, any line incorporating or containing wire, or lead, or any other metal.".

**3. Offences and penalties**—(1) Regulation 42 (2) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by inserting, after paragraph (a), the following paragraph:

"(aa) In the case of an offence against regulation 17 (1)(f) of these regulations, to a fine not exceeding \$2,000; and".

- (2) The said regulation 42 (2) is hereby further amended—
- (a) By omitting from paragraph (c) the expression "9,", and substituting the expression "3, 13, 14,":
- (b) By inserting in paragraph (d) after the expression "40 (1) (c), ", the expression "46,".
- 4. Taking fish for scientific or other purposes—The proviso to regulation 45 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by inserting, after the words "Internal Affairs or", the words ", with the prior consent of the Secretary or his appointee,".
- 5. Increase in licence fees—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the Third Schedule, and substituting the Third Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.
- **6. Restrictions on lures**—The Fourth Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting from clause 2 (b) of Column 1 the words ", Lake Okataina".
- 7. Species of noxious fish—The Fifth Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting from the column headed "Scientific Name"—
  - (a) The words "Clarias batrachas", and substituting the words "Clarias batrachus":
  - (b) The words "Scadinius erythrophthalmus", and substituting the words "Scardinius erythrophthalmus.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations amend the Rotorua and Taupo Trout Fishing Regulations 1980. Regulation 2 reintroduces the general prohibition on the use of weighted lines, a provision inadvertently omitted from the 1980 consolidated regulations.

Regulation 3 corrects some references in the penalty provisions, and provides for an increased maximum penalty (from \$1,000 to \$2,000) upon conviction for the illegal use of any net, trap, wire netting, or similar device.

Regulation 4 requires the consent of the Secretary for Internal Affairs before an officer of the Ministry of Agriculture and Fisheries can use any explosive or toxic substance to take trout for scientific or other similar purposes.

Regulation 5 increases all fees for licences to fish in the districts.

Regulations 6 and 7 correct errors of description or spelling.
