

THE REPORTING CENTRES NOTICE (NO. 2) 1989

Pursuant to section 126 (2) of the Criminal Justice Act 1985, the Minister of Justice hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Reporting Centres Notice (No. 2) 1989.
 - (2) This notice shall take effect from the 1st day of August 1989.
- 2. Constitution of reporting centres—(1) The land described in the First Schedule to this notice is hereby declared to be a reporting centre to be used with and for the purposes of the High Street Work Centre*.
- (2) The land described in the Second Schedule to this notice is hereby declared to be a reporting centre to be used with and for the purposes of the Halstead Street Work Centre*.
- (8) The land described in the Third Schedule to this notice is hereby declared to be a reporting centre to be used with and for the purposes of the Johnston Street Work Centre†.

FIRST SCHEDULE
