THE RIGHT HON. S. G. HOLLAND PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Rehabilitation Act 1941, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Rehabilitation (Stamp Duties and Registration Fees) Regulations 1944, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Rehabilitation (Stamp Duties and Registration Fees) Regulations 1944* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Regulation 3 of the principal regulations is hereby amended as follows:—

(a) By inserting, after the words "granted under the said Act", the words "or granted by the Board under any other Act to a serviceman or discharged serviceman":

(b) By adding the words "or in relation to any such financial assistance".

3. Regulation 4 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by adding the words "or granted by the Board under any other Act to a serviceman or discharged serviceman".

4. These regulations shall apply in respect of documents executed after the commencement of these regulations and in respect of such documents executed before the date of the commencement of these regulations as have not been stamped or registered, as the case may be, before that date.
