**THE RABBIT DESTRUCTION REGULATIONS 1949,
AMENDMENT NO. 22**

At the Government House at Wellington this 22nd day of May 1956

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE GOVERNMENT IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Rabbits Act 1955, His Excellency the Administrator of the Government, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Rabbit Destruction Regulations 1949, Amendment No. 22, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Rabbit Destruction Regulations 1949* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. The Second Schedule of the principal regulations, as substituted by regulation 2 of the Rabbit Destruction Regulations 1949, Amendment No. 17, is hereby amended by inserting therein in its appropriate alphabetical order the following item:
